

POLK COUNTY FAIR KING AND QUEEN APPLICATION

Each 4-H Club and FFA Chapter may nominate one candidate of at least the age of 16 and no more than 21 years by August 10, 2017. **Each candidate will be interviewed by a panel of judges on June 10, 2017 at the Polk County Extension Office between the hours of 8 am and noon. There will not be an alternate date for interviews, but there is the potential for phone interviews that morning or pre-recording an interview and submitting it to the judges to watch on Saturday.** Crowning of the king and queen and their courts will be announced on Wednesday, July 19. Each candidate should read, understand and accept the code of conduct. There is a copy of the rules on line in the Polk County Fair Book. Candidates need to submit their completed application, to the Polk County Extension Office at 1625 Adventureland Drive, Suite A, Altoona, IA 50009 no later than **5pm on May 15, 2017.** (Please note application answers are not limited to the space provided) No late entries will be accepted. **Pictures must be attached to the applications on May 15.**
