

Polk County Fair King and Queen Application

Each 4-H Club and FFA Chapter may nominate one candidate of at least the age of 16 and no more than 21 years by the first day of the Iowa State Fair. **Each candidate will participate in a group interview and individual interview on the day of judging. There will not be any video interviews.** Crowning of the king and queen and their courts will be announced during the fair (see schedule). Each candidate should read, understand and accept the code of conduct. There is a copy of the rules online in the Polk County Fair Book. Candidates need to submit their completed application, to the Polk County Extension Office at 1625 Adventureland Drive, Suite A, Altoona, IA 50009 no later than **5 pm on May 15**. (Please note application answers are not limited to the space provided) No late entries will be accepted. **Pictures must be attached to the applications on May 15. The picture should be no larger than a 4x6.**
